Vice-Chairman Stewart made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Cutright, to approve the application for a certificate of appropriateness for the replacement of various exterior light fixtures on property located at 212 N. Main Street, as presented, in that the proposal is compatible with the architectural character of the existing dwelling and meets the standards set forth in Section 610.07 of the Town of Gordonsville Land Development ordinance. The motion carried 3-0.
