The members of the BAR discussed the request for Certificate of Appropriateness for 300 N. Main Street.

Vice-Chairman Stewart made a motion, seconded by Mr. Regan, to approve the application for a certificate of appropriateness for the installation of a white wooden picket fence to enclose the rear yard of property located at 300 N. Main Street in that the proposal is compatible with the architectural character of the existing dwelling and meets the standards set forth in Section 610.07 of the Town of Gordonsville Land Development ordinance. The motion carried 3-0.
