



NEW U.S. FLAGS FOR THE TOWN OF GORDONSVILLE

The flags that fly on Main Street Gordonsville are loved and admired by many.

As you may know the current flags were purchased some years ago by the Gordonsville VFW Post 7638 who put the flags up and then took them down for each occasion. The Gordonsville VFW Post 7638 asked the Gordonsville Police Department to take over this request, which they have happily done for years.

The Gordonsville Police Department are currently seeking donations to purchase all new flags, posts and hardware. There are currently 53 flags that would be placed on the street. The need for a total of 70 new flags and poles would fully line the street.

The approximate cost of a flag, post and hardware is \$65.00. You are invited to contribute toward this goal. Contributions of any amount are appreciated. Funds received above the cost of the flags will be retained for upkeep, care and replacement of the flags.

Many are donating a flag in honor or memory of loved ones who served in the military. Flags can be donated in *honor* or *memory* of anyone and businesses and other groups may donate and be recognized as a sponsor.
